THEME: DISCOVER DINOSAURS

Questions/Ideas:

Making Salt Dough: Let's measure the ingredients (1 cup salt, 2 cups flour, 3/4 cup water). Let's divide the mixture into balls of the same/equal size.

Salt Dough Fossils: Press the dinosaur in carefully. What do you think will happen to the dough when we leave it in the sun/somewhere warm? Let's keep checking it every hour.

Dinosaur Dig: What do paleontologists use to dig for dinosaurs? Why do they use paint brushes? What can you find in the sand with your brush? Be very careful!

Skeleton Art: Can you feel the bones in your body? Are bones hard or soft? Let's make the skeleton of a dinosaur together.

Where do you think the bones should go? How many bones are there?
